Frontline Doulas announce the 2022 Frontline Doula Community Health Advocate Program :

Addressing Health Inequities in Maternal Health with Doulas/Community Health Advocates

This program is funded by a community investment grant from Blue Shield of California as a part of their Maternal Child Health Equity Initiative. It will offer no cost Doula/CHA support to Black families in Los Angeles County.

WHEN does the program begin? February 2022 through October 2022 in Los Angeles County.

WHO will the Doula/CHA's serve? For families that identify as Black or African-American with due dates of March 15 to August 15, 2022. Doulas can provide family centered services, that are trauma informed, to encourage safe and respectful care to birthing communities that have been historically marginalized.

WHAT is a doula/community heath advocate (CHA)? As a part of this new program, our amazing community doulas have undergone rigorous training to serve as community health advocates (CHA) in addition to providing the excellent care Frontline Doulas are known for.

- Supports birthing people in prenatal visits, labor, and delivery, and post-delivery follow up.
- Provides physical, culturally appropriate emotional, and informational support.
- Conducts screenings prior to delivery for emotional wellness and health concerns.
- Provides referrals to any needed mental health, trauma-targeted or social service needs.

HOW does a Doula/CHA work? Doulas can provide family centered services, that are trauma informed, to encourage safe and respectful care to birthing communities that have been historically marginalized.

- Meetings between the doula/CHA and mother/birthing family
- Development of individualized birth plans with clients to ensure an empowered childbirth experience.
- Attendance of childbirth to support labor/delivery, postpartum visits and lactation education.
